
MESSAGE FROM THE ASSISTANT DIRECTOR





CONTINUOUS INTERNAL EVALUATION (CIE)



As a part of its Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE), St. Francis College, Koramangala, conducts two internal examinations in each semester for a duration of 90 minutes. These exams are conducted strictly in conformity with the Bangalore Central University pattern (in terms of question papers, evaluation practices, seating arrangements, timetable etc.).

The pass mark for each subject is 40%. To compute the grades, equal weightage is given to both the internal exams. Information with regard to the performance in the CIE is communicated to the parents. After each CIE an 'Open Day' is organised to enable parents/guardians to monitor their ward's progress and performance.

After the exam, Progress Reports indicating the marks and term attendance are dispatched to the parents/guardians. These reports have to be signed and returned to the class mentors during the meet organized. This enables the college as well as the parents/guardians to keep track of the student's growth.

The scheduled dates of the CIE are announced in the college calendar. The time table is announced at least 10 days prior to the commencement of the examination. Attending the CIE is mandatory. Prior permission is required for absentisim from internal examinations. In addition to the internal exams, class tests are conducted by the departments for constant evaluation of the students.



ATTENDANCE

30% of the final grade is allotted for internal assessment, in alignment with the norms of Bangalore Central University. The internal assessment grades are based on attendance, tests and seminars/assignments/presentations. As per the Bangalore Central University norms, 75% attendance in each subject is the minimum requirement for examination eligibility. However, as part of its academic culture, the college makes it mandatory for every student to possess at least 85% of actual attendance in each subject. Students with attendance below the required level will not be permitted to appear for the university examination.

LEARNING MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

The Student ERP is a learning system that brings together students and teachers on an online platform so that the learning and teaching process never stops. The interactive system allows teachers to post assignments and grade papers, continually helping students through their journey to knowledge.

Students can use their registration numbers and passwords to access the site on the internet. They can check their attendance and progress reports, download hall tickets, print progress reports and access course materials through the Learning Management System (LMS).

Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) is the campus management software to provide online solution for the academic needs of the students. The students and their parents can access this application through web and internet-compatible mobile phones.

RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT CELL

The Research and Development Cell of St. Francis College, Koramangala, facilitates and encourages research culture among the faculty and students. Its prime role is to inculcate research skills in students and encourage quality research publications. The R&D cell takes the responsibility of creating a workspace to attract the best talent and strives continuously to pool skills and internal resources and publish quality research papers in leading journals.

ACADEMIC SUPPORT

Apart from excellent infrastructure and staff, our college considers the students as top priority and provides them complete support.

Our teachers are always available to address their problems and our administration and management staff readily cater to their needs.

With constant observation we try to accommodate our students' needs as well as furnish the best of facilities for their ease. Extra classes are provided for the students' who require additional help or subject clarification.



INFRASTRUCTURE AND FACILITIES

The campus includes 48 audio-visual enabled classrooms spread across seven floors. The Campus is Wi-Fi enabled for continuous access to the internet. It has well-equipped Laboratories, a seminar room and auditorium for co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

Staff Cabins are on each floor in the academic block. Parking facilities are available for two-wheelers and four-wheelers inside the campus.

The campus has a canteen on the ground floor and elevators to access all the floors.

Computer Labs

The Computer labs are well equipped with state-of-the-art systems and all major and necessary software needed and used by the students. The lab is internet enabled and is open during and after class hours to meet students' requirements. Lab assistance at all times is also provided.

Seminar Halls

St. Francis College, Koramangala, has two symposium rooms for conferences, conventions and other programs. The rooms are well furnished with overhead projectors, audio-visual systems and comfortable seating.

Library

The Library at St. Francis College, Koramangala, is stocked with all new edition books to keep the students updated on current knowledge. An e-library is set up so that our students can access our collection from their computers; this is to keep with the times as learning needs to be fast and efficient. Two student reading rooms are also present on campus.

Reprographic Centre

A Reprographic Centre is situated on the ground floor of the building. The centre caters to all stationery requirements of the students along with other services like photocopying, scanning, colour printing and binding.

Chapel/Meditation Room

To find a moment of peace from all the hustle bustle of everyday life, to relax and converse with the self and a higher power and to reflect and meditate, St. Francis College, Koramangala, has a chapel on campus. The chapel is not restricted to anyone and everyone looking for a moment of quiet can visit the chapel and leave with a clearer and calmer headspace.



The faculty members of St. Francis College not only possess the required scholarly expertise, but also have a strong sense of passion and commitment to teaching. The focus of all their efforts is the student. To engage the students, they use a wide variety of innovative methods to supplement their classroom lectures facilitating and maximizing the learning ability of the students through case studies, student seminars presentations, quizzes, projects and assignments, special problem solving sessions, books and film reviews, field trips, ICT enabled learning, guest lectures, role play, discussions, debates, class tests, Mid Semester Exams (MSE) and End Semester Exams (ESE).

Our teachers believe that knowledge comes from all around and not just the books. This infuses in them a deeper understanding of the students and their specific needs, thus tailoring their coaching to the demands of the corporate sector whilst igniting the Entrepreneurial spirit.





Anti-Ragging Policy

The Anti-Ragging cell on campus collects a written and signed affidavit from all students and their parents/guardians at the time of admission. The Committee keeps itself alert to any instances of ragging. It is the responsibility of the Committee to ensure prompt action if and when there is a case of ragging.

Students who have complaints must not involve in any form of the agitation, strike, grouping inside the campus, destruction of property and disturbance of classes to put up their demands. Disciplinary or legal actions will be taken against students who involve in the same.

However, if the students have grievances pertaining to ragging, insulting and abuse they have to bring it to the notice of the committee, and effective action will be taken.

Ragging in any form is taken as a serious offence in the college; legal and severe action will be taken to stop the offenders.

Students Grievance Redressal Cell

The grievance cell aims at solving student problems and maintaining order and harmony in the college campus. Students undergoing trauma, harassment or any bullying are encouraged to report their grievances immediately. The college protects the human rights of all its students giving them freedom and autonomy to shape their lives.

The grievance cell looks to clearing the path for its students who are hindered by troubles caused by various circumstances.



Student Outreach Programs

To make the students socially responsible and accountable to the society, St. Francis College, Koramangala, encourages and drives the students to be communally aware and work with the community in close proximity.

Students of St. Francis College, Koramangala, hand in hand with students from other prestigious colleges participated in the Polio Eradication Drive organised by Rotary International, WHO (World Health Organisation) and Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation and UNICEF. Our students dedicated their time and effort one Sunday to administer polio drops to children in the neighbouring villages. Our stance of moulding socially responsible and collectively happier adults of tomorrow has taken a kick start with this Polio Eradication Campaign.

Students play an important role in society as catalysts of change. As a college, we consider it our responsibility to adopt a holistic perspective on the dynamics of education and make it more effective. We seek to adopt several initiatives to increase students' awareness of their social conditions at an early stage. By giving them opportunities to contribute positively to their environment, we encourage qualities of responsibility, thought leadership, determination and empathy. These aspects play a key role in helping students to progress to a higher stage of life by actualizing their full potential and triggering societal change.

Student Council

A student council is present in a representative structure through which the students can become involved in the affairs of the college, working in partnership with the management and staff for the benefit of the college and themselves.

Students who are part of the council have responsibilities towards their peers and the institution. The council members take grievances of their fellow students, and along with the college authorities find a quick and sustainable solution that furthers the growth of the institution as a whole.

The student council oversees the smooth running of the institute's Annual Day function every year and in doing so puts the institutions best foot forward in the presence of other colleges.





- It is mandatory for the students to wear their ID cards in the college campus.
- The college insists on punctuality and regularity in attendance.
- Students should not involve in undisciplined behaviour inside college campus. Students found guilty of the same will be rusticated from the college with immediate effect.
- Ragging is a criminal offense leading to non-bailable arrest, and the college frowns upon any incident that involves ragging. Any student involving in any form of physical and mental ragging of other students in the college will be rusticated from the college immediately with legal action.
- Students will be allowed to leave the campus during working hours only after a gate pass is issued to them by the Principal/Dean.
- The college dress code should be strictly adhered to vis a vis uniforms, footwear, haircut etc.
- Students must attend training sessions, seminars, value added programs, soft skill training, corporate training and campus interviews arranged by the college.
- Students must switch off their mobile phones during class hours.
- Leave letters signed by parents/guardians must be presented by the students in case of absence for more than one day.
- The college campus is strictly reserved for students and staff, and students are not allowed to bring any outsiders/friends/relatives to the college without prior permission from college authorities.
- Damage to college property, however small, will not be overlooked. Students / parents would have to bear the expenses of the damage caused.
- Change in address/phone number should be brought to the notice of the college administration so as to keep the student files updated at all times.
