### REPORT

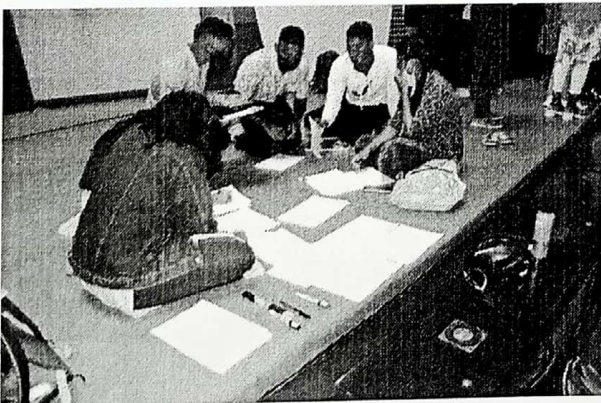
#### INTRODUCTION

World AIDS Day, designated on 1<sup>st</sup> December every year since 1988.

It's an international day dedicated to raising awareness of the AIDS pandemic caused by the spread of HIV infection and mourning those who have died of the disease. The Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS) is a life-threatening condition caused by the human immune deficiency virus (HIV). The HIV virus attacks the immune system of the patient and reduces its resistance to other 'diseases'.

Government and health officials, non-governmental organizations, and individuals around the world observe the day, often with education on AIDS prevention and control. The theme of the World AIDS day for the year 2021 is “*End inequality, End AIDS & End Pandemics*”.

#### PREPARATION PART



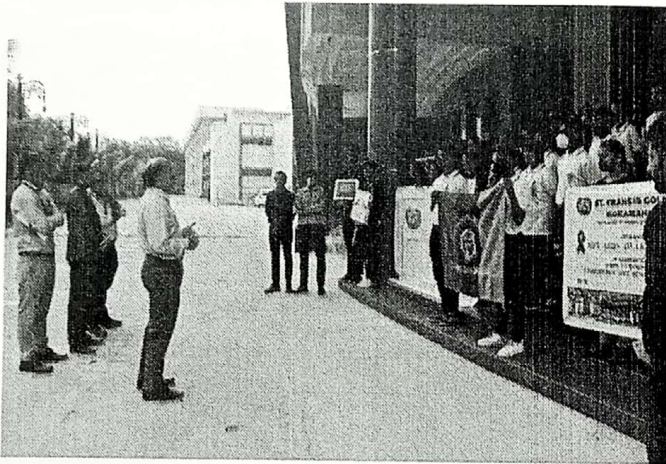
In most of the educational institutions World AIDS Day is celebrated by conducting awareness programmes like rally, drama, street play etc. Student of our institutions too prepared to celebrate the World AIDS Day by conducting

awareness programme to high school students. Students of our college prepared posters, banners, animated images to spread the message on AIDS.

Karnataka Public School, Agara, Bengaluru South, Bengaluru was chosen in advance as the venue for having this programme.

## EVENT PART

All volunteers from 3 clubs (NCC, NSS and civil defense) assembled in front of the college with posters, banners and animated images. Before the departure from the campus to the venue, our college Principal Dr. R. N. Subba Rao gave us the words of encouragement and wished success to our endeavours.



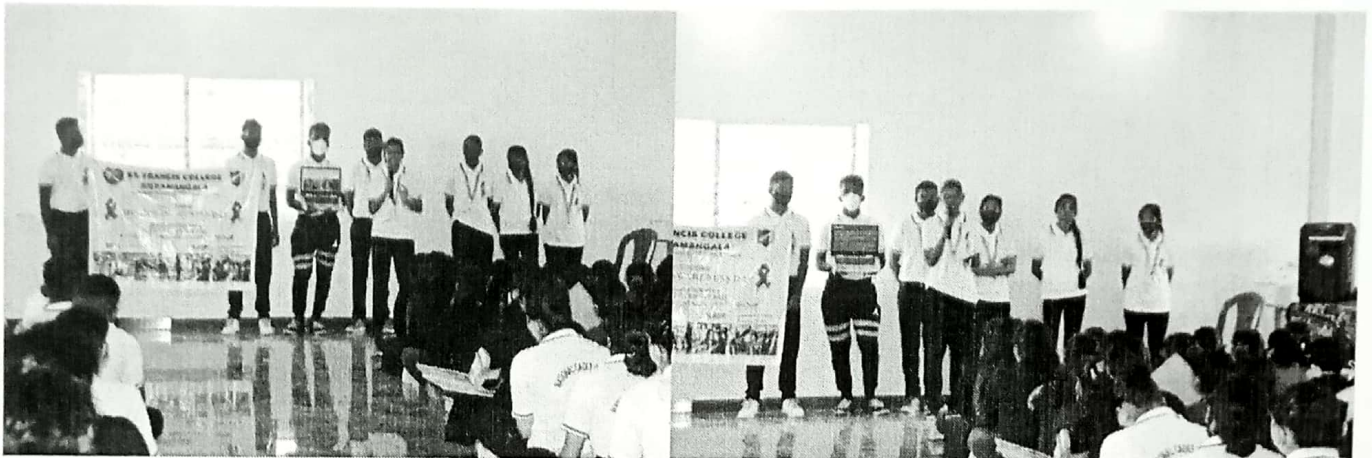
There were 15 NCC cadets, 30 NSS volunteers and 10 civil defense volunteers of our college who participated in this awareness program. The troupe reached the program venue at Karnataka Public School, Agara, at 11:30 am. The stage for the performance was arranged by the Venue School management. Over 250 students were present in the Auditorium to witness the program.



The program began with an introduction. A brief introduction was also given about NCC and its objectives so as to motivate students to join NCC, NSS and Civil defense.

Thereafter the session began by the Cadets. The contents included:

- History of aids
- Causes/ Mode of transmission
- Symptoms
- Precautionary measures
- Diagnosis and treatment

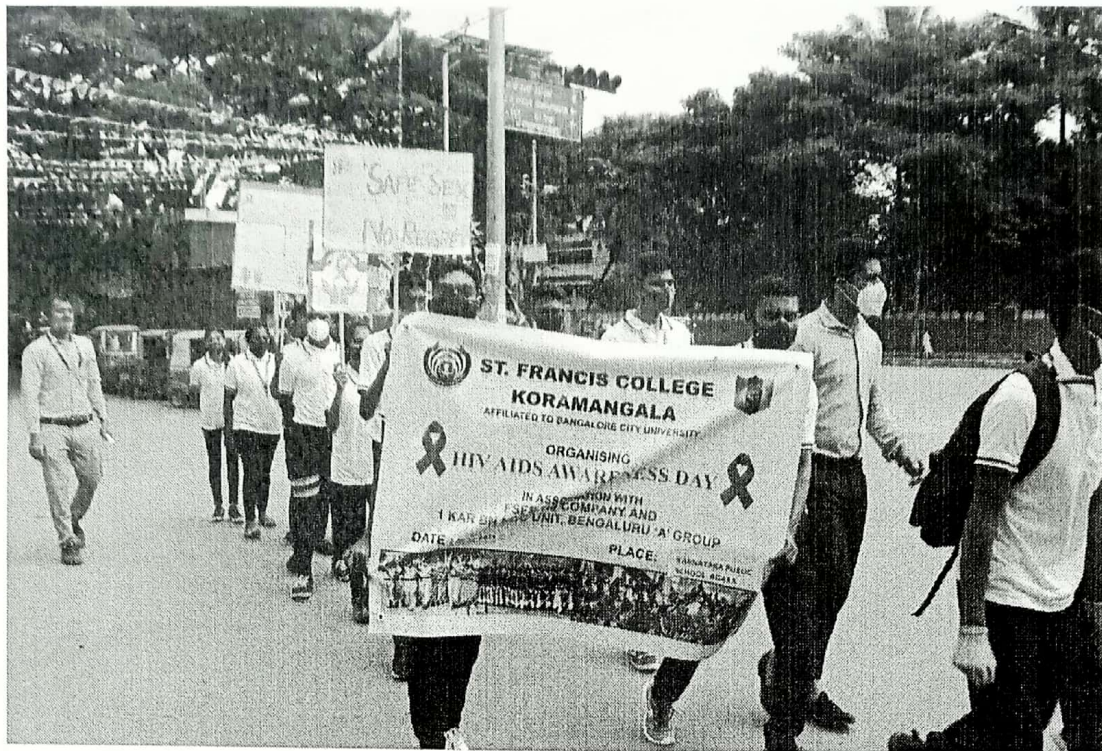


All the above topics were covered by the NCC cadets and briefly explained with illustrations. They also placed before the audience the present scenario of AIDS in world, in our country and our state.

After this, our SW Cadets took a session especially for girls on personal hygiene and self defense mechanism. There was an interactive session, during which we noticed that students had misconceptions on the topic and we were able to clarify and clear their doubts on AIDS, personal hygiene practices, self-defensive mechanism, etc.



After the programme at the venue a rally was conducted on the streets to spread awareness about AIDS to the general public.
