2. Webinar on Corporate Skill Development on Indian Education - 16.07.2022








4. Inauguration and orientation of 2022-23 UG batch of students - 01.09.2022 to 02.09.2022







The Program was planned to help teaching fraternity especially the non-aviation ones to understand the Pedagogy and level of depth to teach in the subject. The activity was executed on through offline mode in the 4th floor seminar hall and 6th floor Aircraft Simulation/Mock classroom to the participants from various colleges at 10 am onwards. The session started with an Introduction, Welcome address by Principal, Prayer. The chief guest of the FDP Dr. H Bhavani, President, BCUTCCM delivered a speech and urged all the faculties to make use of the session's and appreciated the college for having wonderful infrastructure set up for aviation students. The resource persons of the FDP were Pilot. Dennis Almeida, Mr. Sharath, Sindhi College and the in-house resource person was Ms. Vandana N Revankar, Department of Management. The HOD of the BCA department welcomed the speakers for the day. The seminar began with Mr. Sreenath explaining about Kevin Mitnick and Jonathan James the two famous hackers and their experiences in hacking and their life. Later the session was taken over by Mr. Dhanroop where he explained various topics relating to cybercrime, cyberlaws, hacking, spamming, android hacking, social media its advantages& disadvantages and gave students' knowledge about various tools involved in hacking, demonstrated how DDOS attacks and spamming attacks are carried out. He also gave relatable real-life examples about how people have been affected by hacking and other cybercrimes. He cautioned the students and explained them about various measures they should take to safeguard themselves from such cybercrimes. The session was indeed useful and informative for students as they gained knowledge about topics that they were not really exposed to in their curriculum. The outcomes of this seminar on Cyber Security and Ethical Hacking students were able to learn about types of attacks, attackers and security threats and vulnerabilities present in the computer system as well as tools and techniques to safeguard oneself in cyber space. 


12. 5 Day National Hybrid Seminar on Research - 22.05.2023 to 26.05.2023
