
### **4. Practice**

#### **ICT tools in teaching and learning.**


##### **1. Digital projectors and displays:**

All the 68 class rooms and 2 seminar halls are well equipped with the advanced projectors and display screen to make learning more interactive and engaging.





## 2. Audio-visual equipment (e.g., speakers, microphones)
